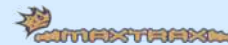

Penguin Beer & Burgers

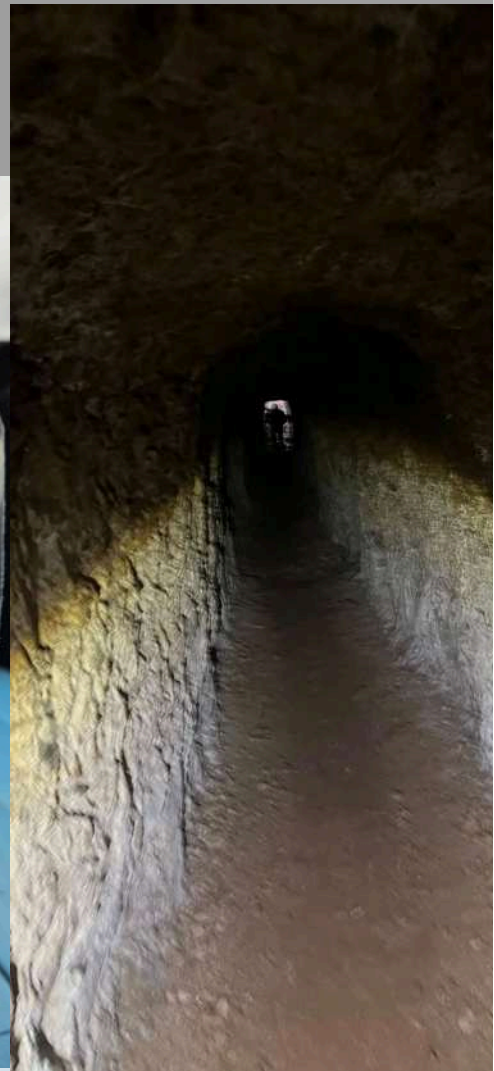
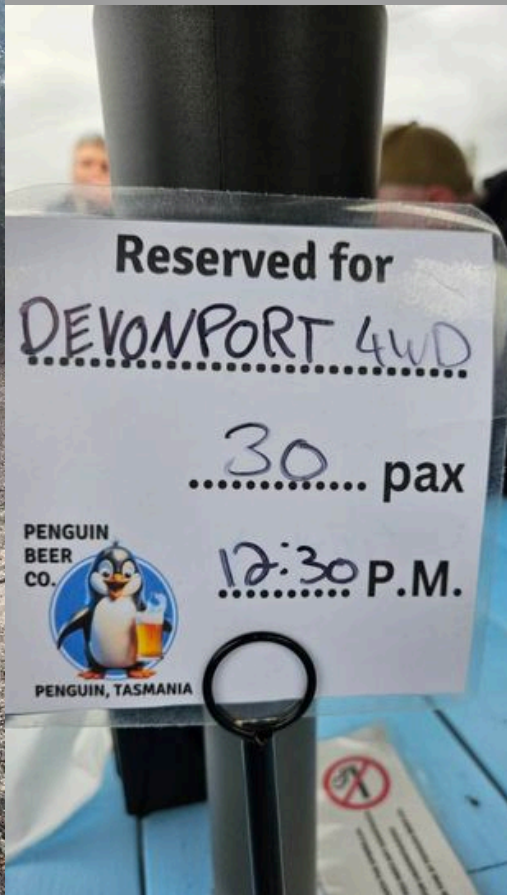
After a slight mix up with start times we headed off from the Penguin Golf club around 9:30 with 17 vehicles in tow, Dane as the trip leader and a mixture of attendees, from the old faithfuls, some visitors, right through to a mother and daughter on their first 4WD experience. Dane had an easy trip planned for the morning, booked in for lunch at Penguin Beer Co. for lunch and then some harder wheeling in the arvo.

We left the Golf club out South Rd, White Hills Rd and then up over the hill, where we had amazing views over the top of the fog towards Black Bluff and Cradle Mountain in one direction and back over Penguin out to the ocean. We dropped back onto Dial Rd before the motocross track and continued on Dial Rd up through the Dial Range around the back of Mt Gnomon, the track is an old gravel road that's had minimum maintenance and is overgrown with fern fronds. Once at the top we headed down the newly sealed road to Ferndene and parked up for a quick walk into Thorsby Tunnel. Dane claimed that his grandmother can do the walk, Garth is now pretty keen to meet Danes grandmother. We walked in past Browning's Tunnel to Thorsby Tunnel and most of us headed into the nearly 100 metre long mine for a look. The mine was an exploratory one, looking for Gold, Silver and copper but it proved to not have much of any.

We drove back up Ironcliffe Road to the carpark and followed it through to Riana, the track became very washed out in parts and proved a challenge for some of the more standard cars. Ironcliffe Rd becomes Cooke's Rd and we pulled onto Pine Rd at Riana and headed back down into Penguin for lunch and a beverage. We met up with a few more members who came along for a lunch catch up.

After lunch we thinned out to 6 vehicles to try some more of the harder tracks, we headed back in the same way with Michael Kerr making it 300 metres off the black top before grenading a cv joint, luckily, he lives less than a kilometre away, returned his car home and jumped in with Lyndon. Dane took us for a bit of a rock crawl around a quarry to test out everyone's vehicles before heading to a nice spot on the Leven River and a cool hillclimb up Purton's Flat Track. It had been drizzling for a while and we couldn't even get up the first and easiest part of the hill, we gave that a miss and decided to follow Dial Creek Rd (or Danes Track) through to Mt Duncan, we left Lyndon's car behind and Simmo waved goodbye at this point. This track had some interesting creek crossings, log bridge and large washouts. Dane was the only person to drive the whole track, Ryan all but put his car on its side, both passenger side wheels were off the ground as it had a little lean on the bank and damaged his right rear quarter and flare, a bit of tricky manoeuvring and a winch and we had Gav up as well. We got to Mt Duncan and followed Ironcliffe Rd back to Danes shed for Pizza.
